- **Ephesians 4:2** Always be humble and gentle. Be patient and accept each other with love.
- **Psalms 61:1** God, hear my cry. Listen to my prayer.
- **Psalms 66:9** He protects our lives and does not let us be defeated.
- **Matthew 7:12** Therefore, whatever you want people to do for you, do the same for them, because this summarizes the Law and the Prophets.
- **Romans 5:8** But Christ died for us while we were still sinners. In this way God shows His great love for us.
- **Psalms 16:8** I keep my eyes always on the LORD. With him at my right hand, I will not be shaken.
- **Proverbs 23:4** Don't wear yourself out trying to get rich. Be wise enough to control yourself.
- **Psalms 23:4** Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
- **John 13:34-35** I give you a new command: Love each other. You must love each other as I have loved you. All people will know that you are my followers if you love each other.
- **Psalms 27:14** Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.
- **Proverbs 23:17** Don't envy sinners. But always respect the Lord.
- **Psalms 31:3** Since you are my rock and my fortress, for the sake of your name lead and guide me.
- **Psalms 32:8** I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you.
- **Psalms 34:8** Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him.
- **Psalms 34:19** The righteous person may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all.
- **Psalms 34:22** The LORD will rescue his servants; no one who takes refuge in him will be condemned.
- **Psalms 37:4** Take delight in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart.
- **Ecclesiastics 11:9** Young people, enjoy yourselves while you are young. Be happy while you are young. Do whatever your heart desires. Do whatever you want to do. But remember that God will judge you for everything you do.
- **Psalms 46:1-3** God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into

the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging.

- **Psalm 55:22** Cast your cares on the LORD and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken.
- **Psalm 62:6** Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken.
- **Psalm 90:17** May the favor of the Lord our God rest on us; establish the work of our hands for us—yes, establish the work of our hands.
- **Micah 6:8** Do what is right to other people. Love being kind to others. And live humbly, trusting your God.
- **Psalm 118:14** The LORD is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation.
- **Psalm 119:105** Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.
- **Psalm 119:114-115** You are my refuge and my shield; I have put my hope in your word. Away from me, you evildoers, that I may keep the commands of my God!
- **Luke 6:31** Do for other people what you want them to do for you.
- **Psalm 119:50** My comfort in my suffering is this: Your promise preserves my life.
- **Psalm 119:71** It was good for me to be afflicted so that I might learn your decrees.
- **Psalm 120:1** I call on the LORD in my distress, and he answers me.
- **Psalm 121:1-2** I lift up my eyes to the mountains - where does my help come from? My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.
- **Psalm 121:7-8** The LORD will keep you from all harm - he will watch over your life; the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.
- **Psalm 145:8** The Lord is kind and shows mercy. He does not angry quickly but it full of love.
- **Psalm 145:18-19** The LORD is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth. He fulfills the desires of those who fear him; he hears their cry and saves them.
- **Proverbs 2:7** He holds success in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless,
- **Proverbs 3:5-6** Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.
- **Proverbs 11:25** A generous person will prosper; whoever refreshes others will be refreshed.

- **Proverbs 16:3** Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and he will establish your plans.
- **Proverbs 17:17** A friend loves you all the time.
- **Proverbs 3:11-12** My child, do not reject the Lord's discipline. And don't be angry when he corrects you. The Lord corrects those He loves just as a father corrects the child that he likes.
- **Proverbs 15:1** A gentle answer will calm a person's anger. But an unkind answer will cause more anger.
- **Isaiah 26:3** You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.
- **Isaiah 41:13** For I am the LORD your God who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you.
- **Isaiah 40:31** But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
- **Isaiah 41:10** So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
- **Isaiah 54:17** No weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me," declares the LORD.
- **Ephesians 6:1** Children, obey your parents the way the Lord wants. This is the right thing to do.
- **Lamentations 3:25** The LORD is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him.
- **Jeremiah 29:11** For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.
- **Nahum 1:7** The LORD is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him,
- **Zephaniah 3:17** The LORD your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing."
- **Matthew 6:25-26** Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? ²⁶ Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?
- **Matthew 6:33** But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

- **Matthew 7:7-8** Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. ⁸ For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.
- **Matthew 11:28** Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.
- **Matthew 5:9** Those who work to bring peace are happy. God will call them his sons.
- **Luke 10:19** I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.
- **Luke 11:9-10** So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.
- **John 3:16** For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- **John 6:47** Very truly I tell you, the one who believes has eternal life.
- **John 14:27** Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
- **John 15:4** Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.
- **John 15:13** Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.
- **John 16:33** I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.
- **Philippians 4:8** Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.
- **1 Corinthians 10:13** No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.
- **Romans 12:17-18** ¹⁷Do not repay evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. ¹⁸If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
- **Romans 12:21** Do not let evil defeat you. Defeat evil by doing good.
- **1 Corinthians 16:13** Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong.
- **Ephesians 4:31-32** Do not be bitter or angry or mad. Never shout angrily or say things to hurt others. Never do anything evil. Be kind and loving to each other. Forgive each other just as God forgave you in Christ.

- **2 Corinthians 4:8-9** We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; ⁹ persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.
- **2 Corinthians 4:16-18** Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.
- **2 Corinthians 5:7** For we live by faith, not by sight.
- **2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come. The old has gone, the new is here!
- **Romans 8:6** The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace.
- **Romans 8:28** And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him who have been called according to his purpose.
- **Romans 8:31** What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?
- **Romans 8:38-39** For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- **Romans 15:4** For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope.
- **Ephesians 3:17-19** so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.
- **Ephesians 3:20-21** Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
- **Ephesians 6:10-11** Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
- **Philippians 4:6-7** Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
- **Philippians 4:19** And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

- **Colossians 3:15** Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.
- **2 Thessalonians 3:3** But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.
- **2 Timothy 1:7** For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.
- **2 Timothy 3:16-17** All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- **2 Timothy 4:18** The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
- **Hebrews 2:18** Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.
- **Hebrews 3:6** But Christ is faithful as the Son over God's house. And we are his house, if indeed we hold firmly to our confidence and the hope in which we glory.
- **Hebrews 4:12** For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
- **Hebrews 13:5** Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
- **Leviticus 19:18** Forget about the wrong things people do to you. You must not try to get even. Love your neighbor as you love yourself.
- **James 1:2-4** Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
- **James 1:12-15** Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him. When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire, he is dragged away and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.
- **James 4:7-8** Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.
- **1 Peter 5:7** Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

- **Colossians 3:17** Everything you say and everything you do should all be done for Jesus your Lord. And in all you do, give thanks to God the Father through Jesus.
- **1 John 4:18** There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.
