a time to look back and see what all work pending, what all unattended duties to be finished, what all resolutions still remain unfulfilled, a time to be grateful for the ways we were lead the past months,

a time to dedicate for living a better life than before ...



Vicar's Message

As December passes, New Year 2016 will be embracing us. Why wait for a month time to take new resolutions when a new month is at our resolutions is remind us that we must have the minimum daily requirements of vitamins and minerals if we are to be physically

healthy. December is a month which reminds us of the <u>UNCONDITIONAL SUBMISSION</u> of Mother Mary, Joseph and many others to the will of God to fulfill His plan of salvation. Let's plan a little different this time. Let us resolve to start a good diet for our health that too from the month of celebration, the month of submission, the month to revitalize, month of check-list, etc. The psalmists David in Psalms 105: 1 - 4 proposes tips to be fit and healthy. Physical fitness depends on spiritual health, so let's see what suggestions David wants us to do...

The first requirement is <u>PRAISE</u>. "Oh give thanks to the Lord ... Sing to Him, Sing psalms to Him" (vv. 1, 2). Praise means giving thanks for all that God is, all that He does and all that He shares with us. Praise is rejoicing in the presence of the Lord because of who He is and because we are His children. Praise is powerful!!! When we do that, the praise will flow not only from our lips but also from our heart. The Lord delights to give "the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness" (Isa. 61: 3). Yes, "it is good to sing praises to our God" – at all times (Ps. 147: 1) Why? The reason for praise is JESUS CHRIST

"Praise, my soul, the King of heaven, To His feet your tribute bring; Ransomed, healed, restored, forgiven, evermore His praises sing". – Lyte

- "Call upon His name" (v. 1). PRAYER is the second requirement. We might have often read the signboards warning us: EMPLOYEES ONLY, DO NOT ENTER, AUTHORIZED VEHICLES ONLY, NO TRESPASSING, etc. Feels embarrassed, when told that you are not welcome, you are barred. Isn't it? It makes me grateful that God sets no restriction on who may come to Him. Those who come to God encounter no "Keep Out" signs. Through prayer, God the Father allows us immediate and unlimited access to Him because His Son Jesus Christ has opened the way to all of us (Eph. 2: 18; Matt. 11: 28; John 6; 37; 7: 37). What a privilege we enjoy: unrestricted fellowship, helpline 24* 7 online... yea, "God's throne is always accessible to His children". Celebrate and enjoy the opportunity.
- The third requirement is well evident in the vv. 1 -3, "Make known His deeds among the peoples... Talk of all His wondrous works. Glory in His holy name", yea, it is <u>WITNESSING</u>. If we only praise and pray but don't present the Lord to other people, our lives will become narrow, shallow and selfish. We need to tell others that He is the Savior. Hope you remember the story of an old man walking on a beach. Encountering hundreds of starfish, washed ashore because of high tides, dying under the heat of the burning sun, he started throwing them back into the sea. A passerby asked, 'What are you doing?' The old man replied, 'Saving their lives'. 'You can't possibly save all these starfish' retorted the passerby. 'Right,' replied the old man, 'but <u>it</u> makes a big difference to each one I do save.' Luke 15 reminds us how heaven rejoiced when I the sinner was saved. This reminds me my duty join the ranks of those who reach other souls with the rescuing grace of Jesus. Yea, "When you've been rescued, you'll want to rescue others."

The final requirement is <u>SEEKING</u> His face. "Seek the Lord and His strength; seek His face evermore!" (v. 4). In other words, live in the light of God's countenance. Live with the smile of God upon your life and seek to please Him alone. Remember the material and spiritual blessings we enjoy is the gift from God and He is the true owner of all we possess (1 Chron. 29: 11). Even our bodies do not belong to us (1 Cor. 6: 19 - 20). So, let's never take our Father for granted, but use wisely and gratefully all that He has given us.

Let December 2015 be a month of preparation as we enter the Advent season. Let the celebrations, carols, rituals, etc., be such that they ensure the real presence of Christ, and everyone should experience peace and joy of Christmas.

May the joy of redemption shine through us this Christmas, and throughout the days ahead.
